Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
Sec. 1. Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

Board of Trustees of the University of Maine System
All Other \$8,400,000
Provides funds for modernization of classrooms and laboratories and for facility
and technology upgrades for university centers to increase student capacity at
university centers in economically disadvantaged communities.
SUMMARY
This bill provides a one-time appropriation of \$8,400,000 to the University of Maine System for technology and facility
upgrades at university centers. The funds must be used to increase student capacity at centers in economically
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disadvantaged communities across the State.
