

10 This bill seeks to establish the Watercraft Enforcement Fund to

16 inland harbor masters, education, safety and the administration
of the expanded rule-making authority by the Commissioner of
Inland Fisheries and Wildlife. The fund would receive a portion
of money collected for watercraft registrations throughout the
State.
