in writing by December 15, 2000 to the Executive Director of the Legislative Council and to the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over state and local government matters. After receipt of the report, the committee may report out legislation, based on the commission's recommendations, to the First Regular Session of the 120th Legislature.'

Further amend the resolve by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

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FISCAL NOTE

The Legislature will incur some minor additional costs to display a plaque and a flag or flags honoring veterans of the Vietnam War from Maine in the Hall of Flags in the State House. These costs can be absorbed within the Legislature's existing budgeted resources.

The additional costs associated with developing a formal process and submitting the required report can be absorbed by the Maine Historic Preservation Commission utilizing existing budgeted resources.'

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SUMMARY

This amendment amends the original resolve by adding a flag or flags to the items that will be displayed in the State House Hall of Flags to honor veterans of the Vietnam War. It also adds a new section requiring that the Maine Historic Preservation Commission develop and recommend to the Legislative Council and to the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over state and local government matters a more formalized, permanent process through which to handle future requests for adding new plaques, flags or other commemorative State House Hall of Flags. The Historic items to the Preservation Commission is required to report in writing on its proposal to the committee and the Executive Director of the Legislative Council by December 15, 2000. It also authorizes the committee to report out legislation based on the commission's recommendations. The amendment also adds a fiscal note.
