**Resolve, to Recognize Veterans of the Vietnam War in the State House  
Hall of Flags.**

Approved for introduction by a majority of the Legislative Council pursuant to Joint Rule 203.

2           **Sec. 1. Commission established. Resolved:** That a commission is  
established to arrange for a plaque, to be displayed in the Hall  
of Flags in the State House, to honor the veterans of the Vietnam  
4 War from Maine; and be it further

6           **Sec. 2. Commission membership. Resolved:** That the commission  
consists of 5 members: 3 members appointed by the Governor, one  
8 member appointed by the President of the Senate and one member  
appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives. The  
10 members of the commission serve without pay or expenses; and be  
it further

12           **Sec. 3. Duties. Resolved:** That the commission shall develop a  
14 design, choose a site, accept donations and make arrangements for  
the plaque to be displayed in the State House Hall of Flags; and  
16 be it further

18           **Sec. 4. Funding. Resolved:** That the commission may seek  
outside sources of funding; and be it further

20           **Sec. 5. Consultation; reports. Resolved:** That the commission  
22 shall consult with the State House and Capitol Park Commission to  
ensure the appropriateness of the design and location of the new  
24 plaque within the State House Hall of Flags. When the commission  
has agreed upon an appropriate location and design, but not later  
26 than November 1, 2000, the commission shall submit its initial  
report to the Executive Director of the Legislative Council. A  
28 final report must be submitted to the Executive Director of the  
Legislative Council by December 1, 2000.
