The Public Utilities Commission may require additional Other 5 Special Revenue funds allocations if there is a significant increase in the number of requests for staff to facilitate 8 negotiated settlements in adjudicatory proceedings.'

SUMMARY

This amendment replaces the bill. This amendment provides that if the Public Utilities Commission receives a written request from all of the parties in an adjudicatory proceeding that one or more staff advocates be appointed to facilitate a negotiated settlement in the proceeding, the commission must either grant the request or issue a written order explaining the reasons why the commission denies the request.
