Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. Construction reimbursement. The Bureau of Elder and
Adult Services within the Department of Human Services shall reimburse assisted living facilities that are renovating existing buildings at the same reimbursement rate as for new construction.
