COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1767, L.D. 2480, Bill, "An Act to Allow Police Assistance in Emergency Situations"

Amend the bill in section 1 in the last line (page 1, line 17 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "department." the following: 'For the purposes of this paragraph, "major unplanned incident" means an extraordinary emergency to which a law enforcement agency is unable to adequately respond that presents a substantial and imminent danger to the public safety and that necessitates the cooperation or assistance of other law enforcement agencies.'
