28	issuing authority, as defined in this chapter, shall issue or deny, and reply in writing as to the reason for any denial,
30	within 30 days of the application date in the case of a resident of 5 or more years and within 60 days of the application date in
32	the case of a nonresident or in the case of a resident of less than 5 years. If the issuing authority does not issue or deny a
34	request for a permit renewal within the time limits specified in this subsection, the validity of the expired permit is extended
36	until the issuing authority issues or denies the renewal. Notwithstanding any other provision of this subsection, the
38	issuing authority shall grant or deny a request for a concealed firearms permit, and reply in writing as to the reason for any
40	denial, within 3 business days of the application date in the case of an application by a person protected by a protective
