26	section. This reimbursement for wages or salary is in addition to the amount required to be reimbursed under section 6103.'

30	FISCAL NOTE
32	Requiring that certain individuals must be reimbursed for wages lost due to being fingerprinted on a Saturday or a Sunday
34	may result in significant additional General Fund costs. The amounts can not be determined at this time.
