SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1778, L.D. 2492, Bill, "An Act to Ensure Adequate Funding of Adult Education"

Amend the amendment by striking out all of sections 1 and 2 and inserting in their place the following:

'Sec. 1. Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

\$78,855

Provides additional funds to increase the state subsidy for adult education. Any balance remaining at the end of the fiscal year must carry forward to be used for the same purpose in fiscal year 2000-01.'

FISCAL NOTE

This amendment strikes the General Fund appropriations in fiscal year 2000-01, reducing the cost of the bill by \$163,937 in fiscal year 2000-01. Public Law 1999, chapter 731 includes a
