General Fund	\$78,855	\$163,937

This bill includes General Fund appropriations totaling  
\$78,855 and \$163,937 in fiscal years 1999-00 and 2000-01,  
respectively, for the Department of Education to increase the  
state subsidy for adult education.

This bill also includes adjustments within the General Fund  
and adjustments within the Federal Expenditures Fund to establish  
Adult Education as a separate program within the Department of  
Education's budget.

The Governor's proposed supplemental budget, LD 2510,  
includes \$78,855 and \$163,939 in fiscal years 1999-00 and  
2000-01, respectively, to enhance adult education.'

**SUMMARY**

This amendment strikes the appropriation section of the bill  
and replaces it with a new appropriation section and an  
allocation section. The new sections organize "Adult Education"  
into a separate program within the Department of Education and  
provide a 3% increase in the fiscal year 1999-00 and fiscal year  
2000-01. It also adds a fiscal note to the bill.
