Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not 2 become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and 4 Whereas, adult education is important to the people of this 6 State; and Whereas, more funds are necessary to ensure the availability 8 of education to adults; and 10 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts 12 create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately 14 necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore, 16 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows: 18 Sec. 1.
