COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 957, L.D. 2498, Bill, "An Act to Increase Access to High-quality Jobs Through the Federal Workforce Investment Act"

Amend the bill by striking out all of the emergency preamble.

Further amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 6-E in the 3rd line (page 1, line 32 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "chapter," the following: 'unless inconsistent with federal law,'

Further amend the bill by striking out all of section 2.

Further amend the bill by striking out the emergency clause.

**SUMMARY**

This amendment strikes the provisions of the bill establishing standards and policies for the Department of Labor and the local workforce investment boards to follow in implementing the federal Workforce Investment Act. The amendment retains the section providing that a person in training under the Workforce Investment Act is deemed to be in approved training for purposes of qualifying for unemployment benefits, but provides that the law is not effective if inconsistent with federal law.
