## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

2 Sec. 1. Stimulate rural development. The Maine Rural Development Council, a quasi-independent agency of the State that 4 intergovernmental and an interagency association, is is 6 encouraged by the Legislature to: Provide advocacy for the social and economic needs and 8 1. issues of rural Maine communities, particularly in the most distressed counties of the State; 10 12 2. Coordinate the development of "community capacity building" projects and show innovative approaches to achieving 14 growth in these distressed counties through locally developed strategies, which are driven by civic vision, grounded in communal assets and commanded by local leadership; 16 18 Stimulate rural development innovation and foster the 3. flow of information on "best practices" to these communities; and 20 4. Report annually to the Governor and the Legislature on the effectiveness of these community capacity building projects 22 and recommendations for future action regarding conditions in the 24 rural areas of the State. 26 Sec. 2. Appropriation. The Maine Rural Development Council is a quasi-independent state agency whose members are representatives from intergovernmental and interagency associations concerning rural development issues.
