HOUSE AMENDMENT "C" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1790, L.D. 2510, Bill, "An Act to Make Supplemental Appropriations and Allocations for the Expenditures of State Government and to Change Certain Provisions of the Law Necessary to the Proper Operations of State Government for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 2000 and June 30, 2001"

Amend the amendment by inserting after Part DDDD the following:

PART EEEE

Sec. EEEE-1. Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Part.

Deappropriates a portion of the funds provided in Part A, section 1 for the Governor's Training Initiative Program.

16 This amendment will have no net effect on General Fund
18 appropriations and revenue and a balanced budget is maintained
20 for fiscal year 1999-00 and fiscal year 2000-01. This amendment
22 includes a General Fund deappropriation of \$50,000 from the
Governor's Training Initiative Program in fiscal year 2000-01 and
provides a General Fund appropriation of the same amount to the
Bureau of Labor Standards to educate the public on the effects of
domestic violence in the workplace.

28 This amendment removes \$50,000 in fiscal year 2000-01 from
30 the Governor's Training Initiative Program and provides that
32 amount to raise public awareness of and educate the public and
employers about the issues concerning the effects in the
