FISCAL NOTE

22 This amendment will have no net effect on General Fund
24 appropriations and revenue and a balanced budget is maintained
26 for fiscal year 1999-00 and fiscal year 2000-01. This amendment
28 deappropriates \$30 million in fiscal year 2000-01 from the Maine
Learning Technology Endowment and appropriates the same amount to
the School Renovation program within the Department of Education.

SUMMARY

32 This amendment strikes those sections of Committee Amendment
34 "A" that establish the Maine Learning Technology Endowment and
36 instead appropriates the funds for school construction.
