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## HOUSE AMENDMENT

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## **FISCAL NOTE**

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This amendment reduces the General Fund cost of the bill by \$30,007,710 in fiscal year 2000-01. It includes a General Fund deappropriation of \$30,000,000 in fiscal year 2000-01 from the Maine Learning Technology Endowment and strikes Parts FFF and GGG related to the Maine Learning Technology Endowment. This amendment also includes the elimination of a General Fund appropriation of \$7,710 in fiscal year 2000-01 for the Legislature for a task force related to the Maine Learning Technology Endowment.

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The elimination of the Education Technology Reserve in Part GGG that would have provided up to \$20,000,000 of excess General Fund revenue and available balance remaining from the unappropriated surplus at the close of fiscal year 1999-00 to the Maine Learning Technology Endowment will avoid the diversion of funds that may have otherwise been available for transfer to the Maine Rainy Day Fund, the Retirement Allowance Fund, the State Contingent Account and the Reserve for General Fund Operating Capital.
