HOUSE AMENDMENT "J" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1790, L.D. 2510, Bill, "An Act to Make Supplemental Appropriations and Allocations for the Expenditures of State Government and to Change Certain Provisions of the Law Necessary to the Proper Operations of State Government for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 2000 and June 30, 2001"

Amend the amendment by striking out all of Part R.

Further amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

FISCAL NOTE

This amendment increases the General Fund cost of the bill by \$6,246,487 in fiscal year 2000-01 only as a result of the change of the effective date for the repeal of the snack tax. This amendment will also decrease dedicated revenue to the Local Government Fund for state-municipal revenue sharing by \$335,691 in fiscal year 2000-01.

Due to the projected General Fund unappropriated surplus at the end of the 2000-2001 biennium, a balanced budget is maintained for the 2000-2001 biennium.

SUMMARY

This amendment removes that portion of Committee Amendment "A" that establishes an effective date of January 1, 2001 for the repeal of the snack tax, and instead allows the repeal of the


