HOUSE AMENDMENT "L" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1790, L.D. 2510, Bill, "An Act to Make Supplemental Appropriations and Allocations for the Expenditures of State Government and to Change Certain Provisions of the Law Necessary to the Proper Operations of State Government for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 2000 and June 30, 2001"

PART EEEE

Sec. EEEE-1. Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Part.

Provides a one-time appropriation to the Sunrise Economic Development Council for cranberry development and marketing purposes.'
