HOUSE AMENDMENT "M" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1790, L.D. 2510, Bill, "An Act to Make Supplemental Appropriations and Allocations for the Expenditures of State Government and to Change Certain Provisions of the Law Necessary to the Proper Operations of State Government for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 2000 and June 30, 2001"

Amend the amendment by inserting at the end and before the emergency clause the following:

PART EEEE

Sec. EEEE-1. Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Part.

EDUCATION, DEPARTMENT OF

General Purpose Aid for Local Schools

All Other (\$20,000)

Notwithstanding any other provision of law, provides for the deappropriation of funds that otherwise would be distributed to the City of Portland.'

Further amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.
