Further amend the amendment by inserting after Part DDDD the following:

PART EEEE

Sec. EEEE-1. Child-centered education scholarships. The Department of Education shall establish and administer a program to provide a scholarship to the family of a child attending a school other than the school available in the local public school administrative district or union. The program is available only to those families that meet the following requirements:

- 16 1. The family has an annual adjusted income of less than \$25,000; 18
- 2. The child attends a school other than the available 20 public school; and
- 3. The family resides in a school administrative district or union that ranks in the lowest 20th percentile for performance
 and education achievement in the State.
- 26 The department must make available 1,000 scholarships of \$3,000 each.
- The department may adopt rules, which are routine technical 30 rules, pursuant to the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 5, chapter 375, subchapter II-A, to carry out the purposes of this Part.
- Sec. EEEE-2. Appropriation. The following funds are 34 appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Part.

FISCAL NOTE

This amendment will have no net effect on General Fund 18 appropriations and revenue and a balanced budget is maintained for fiscal year 1999-00 and fiscal year 2000-01. This amendment 20 includes a deappropriation of \$3,000,000 from the General Purpose Aid for Local Schools program and appropriates the same amount to the Child-centered Scholarship Program within the Department of 22 Education. 24

SUMMARY

amendment provides for the establishment of the This Child-centered Scholarship program to provide 1,000 scholarships per year of \$3,000 each to families of children making less than \$25,000 per year living in school districts that rank in the lowest 20th percentile for academic performance if those children attend schools other than the local public school.
