SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1790, L.D. 2510, Bill, "An Act to Make Supplemental Appropriations and Allocations for the Expenditures of State Government and to Change Certain Provisions of the Law Necessary to the Proper Operations of State Government for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 2000 and June 30, 2001"

Amend the amendment in Part YY in section 3 in paragraph A in the last line (page 226, line 46 in amendment) by striking out the following: "\$ 84,000,000" and inserting in its place the following: '\$ 88,000,000'

Further amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

FISCAL NOTE

This amendment increases the debt service limit by an additional \$4,000,000 in fiscal year 2004-05 which will increase the General Fund appropriations that will be required in fiscal year 2004-05 by an additional \$2,800,000. As amended, future General Fund appropriations, estimated to be \$9,800,000, will be required in fiscal year 2004-05 for the Department of Education for these additional debt service costs.


