SENATE AMENDMENT "C" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1790, L.D. 2510

FISCAL NOTE

This amendment directs the State Controller to transfer from excess General Fund revenue up to \$5,000,000 at the close of fiscal year 1999-00 to the Department of Education for school renovation projects. As a result, the Maine Learning Technology Reserve, the Maine Rainy Day Fund, the Retirement Allowance Fund, the State Contingent Account and the Reserve for General Fund Operating Capital may not receive any funds. The effect on these funds and accounts can not be determined at this time.

SUMMARY

This amendment directs the State Controller to transfer 16 \$5,000,000 from excess General Fund revenue to the Department of Education for use in school renovation projects.
