This amendment eliminates the Education Technology Reserve in Part GGG that would have provided up to \$20,000,000 of excess General Fund revenue and available balance remaining from the unappropriated surplus at the close of fiscal year 1999-00 to the Maine Learning Technology Endowment and replaces it with a School Construction Reserve that will transfer up to \$15,000,000 of excess General Fund revenue. This may avoid the diversion of up to \$5,000,000 that may have otherwise been available for transfer to the Maine Rainy Day Fund, the Retirement Allowance Fund, the State Contingent Account and the Reserve for General Fund Operating Capital.

This amendment strikes the Maine Learning Technology Reserve. The amendment creates a School Construction Reserve and also directs the State Controller to transfer any excess General Fund reserve to the Department of Education to buy down the debt on school construction.
