SENATE AMENDMENT "K" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1790, L.D. 2510, Bill, "An Act to Make Supplemental Appropriations and Allocations for the Expenditures of State Government and to Change Certain Provisions of the Law Necessary to the Proper Operations of State Government for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 2000 and June 30, 2001"

Amend the amendment by inserting after Part DDDD the following:

PART EEEE

Sec. EEEE-1. Roll call votes on Internet. It is the intent of the Legislature that all roll call votes be available to the public via the Internet within one hour of the roll call.

Sec. EEEE-2. Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Part.

All Other \$10,000

Provides funds to offset the costs related to placing legislative roll calls on the Internet within one hour of the roll call.'

Further amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

FISCAL NOTE

This amendment increases the General Fund cost of the bill by \$10,000. It includes a General Fund appropriation of \$10,000 in fiscal year 2000-01 to provide the Legislature with additional funding to comply with the requirement to make roll calls available to the public via the Internet within one hour of the roll call.

Due to the projected General Fund unappropriated surplus at the end of the 2000-2001 biennium, a balanced budget is maintained for the 2000-2001 biennium.
