PART MMM

Sec. MMM-1. Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Part.

LABOR, DEPARTMENT OF

Governor's Training Initiative Program

All Other (\$50,000)

Deappropriates a portion of the funds provided in Part A, section 1 for the Governor's Training Initiative Program.

Administration - Bureau of Labor Standards

All Other \$50,000

Provides funds to raise awareness of and  
educate the public and employers about the  
effects and issues of domestic violence in  
the workplace.



**FISCAL NOTE**

This amendment will have no net effect on General Fund  
appropriations and revenue and a balanced budget is maintained  
for fiscal year 1999-00 and fiscal year 2000-01. This amendment  
includes a General Fund deappropriation of \$50,000 from the  
Governor's Training Initiative Program in fiscal year 2000-01 and  
provides a General Fund appropriation of the same amount to the  
Bureau of Labor Standards within the Department of Labor to  
educate the public on the effects of domestic violence in the  
workplace.

**SUMMARY**

This amendment removes \$50,000 in fiscal year 2000-01 from  
the Governor's Training Initiative Program and provides that  
amount to raise public awareness of and educate the public and  
employers about the issues concerning the effects in the  
workplace of domestic violence.
