SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 973, L.D. 2519, "Resolve, to Improve Access to Technical Education and Ensure a Skilled Work Force"

Amend the resolve in section 1 in the last line (page 1, line 30 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "; and be it further" and inserting in its place the following: '.'

Further amend the resolve by striking out all of section 2.

FISCAL NOTE

This amendment strikes the General Fund appropriations, reducing the General Fund cost of the bill by \$2,500,000 in fiscal year 2000-01. Public Law 1999, chapter 731 includes a General Fund appropriation of \$900,000 in fiscal year 2000-01 to the Maine Technical College System for operational support and increased access for students.
