HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1796, L.D. 2521, Bill, "An Act to Promote Safe Mobility for Maine's Aging Population through Education and Community-based, Economically Sustainable Alternative Transportation"

Amend the amendment by striking out all of sections 1 to 5.

Further amend the amendment in section 6 by striking out all of the 4th to last lines (page 4, lines 13 to 48 and page 5, lines 1 to 23 in amendment) and inserting in their place the following:

TRANSPORTATION, DEPARTMENT OF

Transportation Services

All Other \$450,000

Appropriates additional funds for existing senior transportation programs.'

Further amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

FISCAL NOTE

This amendment does not affect the General Fund cost of the bill.

As amended, the bill includes a General Fund appropriation of \$450,000 in fiscal year 2000-01 for the Transportation
