COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1797, L.D. 2522, Bill, "An Act to Establish a Memorial Dedicated to the Civilian Conservation Corps"

Amend the bill by striking out all of section 2 and inserting in its place the following:

Sec. 2. Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

Civilian Conservation Corps Memorial

All Other \$10,000

Provides funds for a portion of the costs of establishing a Civilian Conservation Corps memorial.

Sec. 3. Allocation. The following funds are allocated from Other Special Revenue funds to carry out the purposes of this Act.

This bill includes a General Fund appropriation of \$10,000 in fiscal year 2000-01 to provide funding for a portion of the costs of establishing a Civilian Conservation Corps memorial. The cost to build this memorial is estimated to be \$22,000. The intent is to provide the remaining costs through private funding to be administered by the Capitol Planning Commission. An Other Special Revenue funds allocation of \$12,000 in fiscal year 2000-01 is included to authorize the expenditure of any private funding received by the Capitol Planning Commission for this purpose. The amount of additional dedicated revenue that may be received for this purpose can not be determined at this time.
