2           **Sec. 1. Payment by Bureau of Revenue Services. Resolved:** That  
3 John Calley of Fryeburg be paid \$60,000 for expenses incurred as  
4 the result of an overassessment of sales tax by the State Tax  
5 Assessor. The Bureau of Revenue Services within the Department  
6 of Administrative and Financial Services shall pay John Calley  
7 within 30 days after the effective date of this resolve.
