HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1807, L.D. 2533, Bill, "An Act to Create a New Category of Liquor License and to Exempt Pool Halls, Bowling Alleys and Off-track Betting Facilities from the Prohibition Against Smoking"

Amend the amendment by striking out the substitute title and replacing it with the following:

'An Act to Amend the Liquor Laws to Define Bowling Center Lounge and Create a New Category of License for Pool Halls and to Exempt Bowling Center Lounges and Pool Halls from the Prohibition Against Smoking in Indoor Places'

Further amend the amendment by inserting after the 2nd indented paragraph after the title the following:

'Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §1542, sub-§2, ¶G, as enacted by PL 1993, c. 342, §1 and affected by §9, is amended to read:

G. Smoking is not prohibited in taverns or lounges, including bowling center lounges as defined in Title 28-A, section 2, subsection 4-A.

Sec. 2. 22 MRSA §1542, sub-§2, ¶N is enacted to read:

N. Smoking is not prohibited in pool halls licensed under Title 28-A, section 1063-B.'

Further amend the amendment by striking out all of section 3.

Further amend the amendment in section 6 by striking out all  
of the first line (page 2, line 20 in amendment) and inserting in  
its place the following:

'Sec. 6. 28-A MRSA §1051, sub-§6 is enacted to read:'

Further amend the amendment in section 6 by striking out all  
of subsection 6 and renumbering subsection 7 to be subsection 6.


Further amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering  
any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read  
consecutively.

#### FISCAL NOTE

This amendment reduces the annual General Fund revenue loss  
by \$47,600 beginning in fiscal year 2000-01.

#### SUMMARY

This amendment removes provisions that allow smoking in a  
lounge portion of a Class A restaurant/lounge. It adds bowling  
center lounges and pool halls to the exceptions to the smoking in  
public places law.
