HOUSE AMENDMENT "C" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1807, L.D. 2533, Bill, "An Act to Create a New Category of Liquor License and to Exempt Pool Halls, Bowling Alleys and Off-track Betting Facilities from the Prohibition Against Smoking"

Amend the amendment by striking out the substitute title and replacing it with the following:

'An Act to Amend the Liquor Laws to Create a New Category of License for Pool Halls and Exempt Them from the Prohibition Against Smoking'

Further amend the amendment by striking out all of section 1 (page 1, lines 36 to 45 in amendment)

Further amend the amendment by striking out all of section 3 (page 2, lines 1 to 10 in amendment)

Further amend the amendment by striking out all of section 6 (page 2, lines 20 to 42 in amendment)

Further amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment incorporates the changes made by Senate Amendment "A" to Committee Amendment "A" and strikes the

definition of a bowling center lounge and removes the provisions
that would exempt a bowling center lounge from the ban on smoking.
