SENATE AMENDMENT "C" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1807, L.D. 2533, Bill, "An Act to Create a New Category of Liquor License and to Exempt Pool Halls, Bowling Alleys and Off-track Betting Facilities from the Prohibition Against Smoking"

Amend the amendment by inserting before section 1 the following:

'Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §1542, sub-§4 is enacted to read:

4. Rulemaking; designated smoking areas. The department shall by rule establish standards to require separate ventilation systems for establishments, licensed in accordance with this Title, that contain designated smoking areas as provided in this section. These rules are major substantive rules as defined in Title 5, chapter 375, subchapter II-A.'

Further amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

FISCAL NOTE

The Department of Human Services will incur some minor additional costs related to rulemaking. These costs can be absorbed within the department's existing budgeted resources.
