Medicaid reimbursement of state case management services will increase General Fund revenue by \$218,659 in fiscal year 2000-01. The estimated future increases in General Fund revenue associated with the reimbursement of state case management services will be approximately \$558,676 and \$536,749 in fiscal years 2001-02 and 2002-03, respectively.

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COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "H" to H.P. 1810, L.D. 2536

This bill also includes a Federal Expenditures Fund allocation of \$9,459,344 in fiscal year 2000-01 for the federal match associated with providing residential and day services to 416 nonclass members with mental retardation. The estimated future costs for providing day and residential services for an additional 408 people with mental retardation who are not class members in fiscal years 2001-02 and 2002-03 will be approximately \$20,766,177 and \$22,965,438, respectively.'

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SUMMARY

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This amendment strikes the appropriation section in the bill and adds an appropriation section, an allocation section and a fiscal note.

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
