HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "B" to S.P. 987, L.D. 2540, Bill, "An Act Concerning Fingerprinting and Background Checks for School Employees"

Amend the amendment by striking out all of section 16.

Further amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment strikes the provision of Committee Amendment "B" that requires the fingerprints taken from educational personnel to be removed from the files of the State Bureau of Identification.
