SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 989, L.D. 2542

2 The Bureau of Revenue Services will incur additional costs to audit the additional number of returns added as a result of 4 this amendment. The appropriation included in the bill is sufficient to provide the resources to implement this bill as 6 amended by this amendment.

SUMMARY

This amendment increases the amount of pension benefits exempt from Maine income tax to \$15,000 for individuals filing single returns and to \$30,000 for married persons filing joint returns. This amendment also includes private retirement pension benefits.
