SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1814, L.D. 2547, Bill, "An Act to Implement the Recommendations of the Task Force to Study the Operation of and Support for the Board of Environmental Protection"

Amend the amendment on page 3 by striking out all of lines 2 to 44 and inserting in their place the following:

'Further amend the bill by striking out all of sections 5 and 6 and inserting in their place the following:

'Sec. 5. Allocation. The following funds are allocated from Other Special Revenue funds to carry out the purposes of this Act.

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FISCAL NOTE

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This amendment strikes the General Fund appropriation of \$95,687 in fiscal year 2000-01, eliminating the General Fund costs from the bill. The amendment also includes changes which result in a net Other Special Revenue funds allocation of \$64,745 in fiscal year 2000-01.

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SUMMARY

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This amendment removes the provisions regarding the transfer of funding for the Deputy Commissioner of the Department of Environmental Protection.
