HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1818, L.D. 2552, Bill, "An Act to Allocate from the Fund for a Healthy Maine"

Amend the amendment by striking out all of the emergency preamble (page 1, lines 25 to 39 in amendment)

Further amend the amendment in Part L in section 1 in the 4th line (page 21, line 5 in amendment) by striking out the following: "1999-00"

Further amend the amendment in Part L in section 1 in that part designated "Trust Fund for a Healthy Maine" by striking out all of the 3rd line (page 21, line 26 in amendment) and inserting in its place the following:

'All Other \$11,094,848'

Further amend the amendment in Part L in section 1 in that part designated "Trust Fund for a Healthy Maine" in the last line (page 21, line 37 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "A." the following: 'This allocation represents the fiscal year 1999-00 and fiscal year 2000-01 payments.'

Further amend the amendment in Part L in section 1 by striking out all of the last line (page 21, line 41 in amendment) and inserting in its place the following:

'TOTAL \$38,134,848'

Further amend the amendment by striking out all of Part M.


Further amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

FISCAL NOTE

This amendment makes adjustments to certain allocations and will have no net effect on total allocations from the Fund for a Healthy Maine included in the bill.

SUMMARY

This amendment removes the emergency preamble and emergency clause. It adjusts the allocation to the Trust Fund for a Healthy Maine accordingly. This amendment also removes the requirement that the working capital advance be repaid prior to May 1, 2000.
