2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. P&SL 1973, c. 76, §3, first sentence,** as amended by P&SL
6 1975, c. 47, §3, is repealed and the following enacted in its
8 place:

10 To procure funds to carry out the purposes of this Act, the
12 district may, through its board of directors, borrow money and
14 issue bonds and notes therefor to an indebtedness not to exceed
16 2.0% of the total current state valuation of all towns and
18 plantations that are members of the district.

14 SUMMARY

16 This bill increases the maximum debt limit for Hospital
18 Administrative District #4 (Mayo Hospital) from \$7,000,000 to an
amount not to exceed 2% of the total current state valuation of
all towns and plantations that are members of the district.
