24	Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the summary and inserting in its place the following:
26	'Sec. 1. 13 MRSA §1341 is repealed and the following enacted
28	in its place:
30	§1341. Location
32	1. Mausoleum, crematory or other structure. A community mausoleum, crematory or other structure that holds or contains
34	<u>dead human bodies may only be erected in a cemetery that is at least 20 acres in size and has been in existence and used for</u>
36	<u>burial for at least 2 years preceding the erection of the</u> structure.

40	2. Columbarium. A columbarium that holds or contains the cremated remains of dead human bodies may only be erected in a cemetery that is at least 5 acres in size and has been in
42	existence and used for burial for at least 2 years preceding the erection of the structure.

46	3. Exception. This section does not apply to a structure containing crypts erected or controlled by a church or religious society used for the remains of the clergy or dignitaries of the

The original bill reduced the number of acres from 20 to 5 4 that a cemetery must have in order to erect a columbarium, community mausoleum or crematory. This amendment clarifies that 6 the acreage is reduced only to erect a columbarium.
