

HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1827, L.D. 2561, Bill, "An Act to Ensure Access to Specialists for Injured Workers"

Amend the bill in section 2 in subsection 4 in paragraph B in the last line (page 1, line 51 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "excessive." the following: 'The hearing officer may order the withholding of a certain amount of wages and up to 25% of future benefits of the employee under this Act to satisfy a repayment ordered pursuant to this paragraph.'

SUMMARY

This amendment amends the bill by allowing a hearing officer who orders an employee to repay an employer for unnecessary or excessive treatment to further order the withholding of a certain amount of the employee's future wages and up to 25% of future workers' compensation benefits to satisfy the repayment.
