28	This amendment amends the bill by allowing a hearing officer who orders an employee to repay an employer for unnecessary or
30	excessive treatment to further order the withholding of a certain amount of the employee's future wages and up to 25% of future
32	workers' compensation benefits to satisfy the repayment.
