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

HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 1000, L.D. 2565, Bill, "An Act to Implement the Recommendations of the Task Force to Review Solid Waste Management Policy"

Amend the amendment in subsection 2 in the 6th and 7th lines (page 1, lines 32 and 33 in amendment) by striking out the following: "or that within 4 years this capacity will be available only at a single facility"

SUMMARY

This amendment removes the requirement that the State Planning Office submit a report to the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over natural resources matters when the office finds that within 4 years licensed and available disposal capacity for municipal solid waste or special waste will be available only at a single facility.
