Sec. 2. Payment to Hancock County. Notwithstanding the 14 provisions of the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 36, section 1606, the payment due Hancock County on or before the last day of July 16 2000 must be reduced by \$5,000. The Treasurer of State shall pay the \$5,000 to the Sunset Bay Company as compensation for ferry This amount is intended to provide the payment of 18 service. \$5,000 to the Eagle Island ferry service, doing business as the 20 Sunset Bay Company, as directed by Private and Special Law 1999, chapter 25, section 3, which was not made by the Hancock County 22 commissioners.

Sec. 3. Allocation. The following funds are allocated from Other Special Revenue funds to carry out the purposes of this Act.

Transfers 44 are then made to the other dedicated accounts for certain expenditures related to the Unorganized Territory and to the 46 General Fund to reimburse the General Fund for actual General 48 Fund expenditures included in the municipal cost components.

in fiscal year 2000-01 to the Department of Education, Education in Unorganized Territory program for the cost of roof repair for the Benedicta School. This additional appropriation for these costs will increase budgeted General Fund revenue by an amount equal to the appropriation.

This bill also includes a \$5,000 deallocation and a \$5,000 8 allocation of Other Special Revenue funds in fiscal year 2000-01 to reflect the adjustment of the payment to Hancock County and to 10 authorize the payment to Eagle Island ferry service, doing business as Sunset Bay Company.'

SUMMARY

16 This amendment requires the reimbursement to Hancock County to be reduced by \$5,000 and requires the Treasurer of State to 18 pay that amount to the Sunset Bay Company for ferry service. This payment was not made by Hancock County as required by Private and Special Law 1999, chapter 25, section 3. 20 The amendment increases the amount authorized to allow for the cost 22 of roof repair for the Benedicta School. The amendment also reduces reimbursement to Somerset County to reflect the decision 24 of the county commissioners not to assume control of a private road and adds an allocation and appropriation section and a 26 fiscal note.
