2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 32 MRSA §15208, last ¶**, as enacted by PL 1999, c. 386,
Pt. X, §8, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:

6 A person who is licensed as an elevator and lift inspector
8 and who installs, services or sells elevator or lift equipment
10 may not inspect any equipment that person has installed, serviced
12 or sold within the preceding 12-month period.

12 SUMMARY

14 This bill clarifies current law to prohibit an individual
16 who actually installed, serviced or sold elevator or lift
equipment from inspecting that equipment. This bill also limits
18 the prohibition to a 12-month period following the installation,
service or sale of that equipment.
