2	Sec. 1. 32 MRSA §15208, last ¶, as enacted by PL 1999, c. 386,
4	Pt. X, $\S 8$, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:
6	A person who is licensed as an elevator and lift inspector
	and who installs, services or sells elevator or lift equipment
8	may not inspect any equipment that person has installed, serviced
10	or sold within the preceding 12-month period.
12	SUMMARY
14	This bill clarifies current law to prohibit an individual who actually installed, serviced or sold elevator or lift
16	equipment from inspecting that equipment. This bill also limits the prohibition to a 12-month period following the installation,
18	service or sale of that equipment.
