
SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 1005, L.D. 2573, Bill, "An Act to Prohibit Persons Under 21 Years of Age from Purchasing Handguns"

Amend the amendment in section 2 in that part designated "~~§554-B.~~" in subsection 3 in paragraph A in the first line (page 2, line 19 in amendment) by striking out the following: 'temporary'

Further amend the amendment in section 2 in that part designated "~~§554-B.~~" in subsection 3 in paragraph A by striking out the last 6 lines (page 2, lines 31 to 36 in amendment).

SUMMARY

This amendment clarifies that a handgun may be transferred to a minor with written consent of the minor's parent or guardian or for employment, target practice, hunting or instructions. This amendment also removes the provisions of Committee Amendment "A" specifying how the minor must transport the handgun.
