An Act to Restore the Chaplaincy in the Maine Correctional Center in South Windham.

(AFTER DEADLINE)

(EMERGENCY)

Approved for introduction by a majority of the Legislative Council pursuant to Joint Rule 205.

- Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and Whereas, the position of chaplain at the Maine Correctional Facility in South Windham was abolished in 1991; and
- 8 Whereas, the 90-day period may terminate after the beginning of the next fiscal year; and

Whereas, it is important to provide the funds to reinstate

- 12 the chaplain position as soon as possible; and
- 14 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of 16 Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and 18 safety; now, therefore,

20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

22 Sec. 1. Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.
