42	Sec. 1. Task force. Resolved: That the Attorney General shall convene a task force to study implementation of the marijuana for
44	medical purposes law and to recommend steps to implement the law
46	and provide access to marijuana for medical purposes. The task force shall study the marijuana for medical purposes law enacted by the voters in November 1999, methods of

providing access to marijuana for medical purposes and other 2 implementation and enforcement issues.

The task force must be broadly representative and must 4 include representatives of the following groups and interests: health care professionals, Legislators, law enforcement, public б policy specialists, advocates for the medical use of marijuana and interested members of the public. Legislative members must 8 be appointed as follows:

After consultation with the Attorney General, the 1. 12 President of the Senate shall appoint 2 Senators; and

14 2. After consultation with the Attorney General, the Speaker of the House shall appoint 5 Representatives. When making the appointments, the Speaker shall give preference to 16 members from the following committees: the Joint Standing Committee on Criminal Justice; the Joint Standing Committee on 18 Judiciary; and the Joint Standing Committee on Health and Human 20 Services.

22 Task force meetings must be public meetings. By October 1, 2000, the task force shall report its recommendations and any suggested legislation to the Joint Standing Committee on Health 24 and Human Services and the Joint Standing Committee on Criminal Justice; and be it further 26

28 Sec. 2. Appropriation. Resolved: That the following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of 30 this resolve.

8 This amendment adds an emergency preamble and an emergency clause to the resolve and requires the Speaker of the House to 10 give preference to members of the Joint Standing Committee on Criminal Justice, the Joint Standing Committee on Judiciary and 12 the Joint Standing Committee on Health and Human Services when making appointments to the task force.
