

An Act Regarding Waiting Lists for Limited-entry Lobster Management Zones.

2 declared lobster zone. It specifies that a person who holds a
3 Class I, Class II or Class III lobster and crab fishing license
4 shall indicate that person's request to the Commissioner of
5 Marine Resources in writing by December 15th of the previous
6 licensing year and that a person who does not hold a license must
7 be eligible for a license by December 15th of the previous
8 licensing year. The date of eligibility for a license becomes
9 the date of that person's request to declare a limited-entry zone
10 for purposes of the chronological waiting list maintained by the
commissioner.
